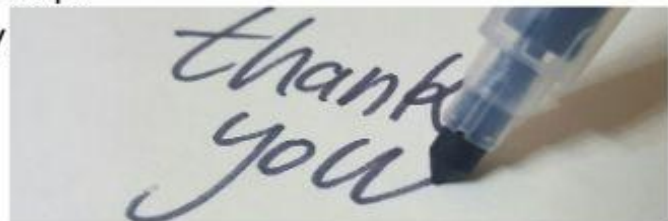


pastor's corner
