Sunday, March 28, 2021 Summary of The Coming King Matthew 21:1-17 Wayne Shelton

Jesus arranges the whole scene. He determines the details. He decides to ride slightly above the crowd into Jerusalem upon a foal of a beast of burden. In essence, Jesus rode into Jerusalem that first Palm Sunday announcing that Israel's Messiah had arrived, just as Zechariah said he would. When Jesus rode into Jerusalem we read that "the whole city was stirred up, saying, 'Who is this?'" (v10). The city was 'stirred up' or 'quaked'; the city quaked like it would 'quake' on Good Friday (at his death) and on Easter Sunday (at his resurrection). And the question that came out of this quaking was the right one: "Who is this?" (v10).
