The Anglican Catholic Church and the G2

As the Anglican Joint Synods communion continues to coalesce, with the union of the Anglican Church in America (ACA) with the Anglican Catholic Church (ACC), which union was achieved at the ACC Provincial Synod in October 2025, we can exclaim that the Anglican Joint Synods (G2) relationship is progressing, strengthening, and drawing us all more closely together. The APA remains fully committed to our full communion agreements with the Anglican Catholic Church (including the ACA) and the Traditional Anglican Church (TAC). The Saint Louis Affirmation Churches are One Sacramental Body, moving forward together in synchronicity, as one, in mission and ministry. The Anglican Catholic Church has now entered a five-year period during which the current Dioceses constituting the ACC and ACA will be amalgamated and

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restructured within the one jurisdiction. We rejoice with our brethren as that process begins to unfold.

July to December 2025

In July, I was able to visit Saint Alban's Church, Joppa, Maryland (6th) and Saint John's Church, Greensboro, North Carolina (13th).

The hallmark of the year for our Diocese was, of course, the glorious LVII Synod of the Diocese of the Eastern United States, held in Greenville, South Carolina, from 28th July to 1st August. We remain deeply grateful to Saint George the Martyr Church in Simpsonville and its Rector, the Very Reverend Paul Rivard, for sponsoring the Synod this year. The Reverend Prebendary Erich Zwingert entirely excelled in his ministry as Diocesan Synod Coordinator, for which we are truly thankful. Undoubtedly, the highlight of Synod this year was the Pontifical Solemn High Mass celebrated at the magnificent Saint Mary's Roman Catholic Church in Greenville, a once-in-a-lifetime and utterly exhilarating experience for all who attended. Our everlasting thanks are extended to the Reverend Father Jay Scott Newman for his exceptional kindness and hospitality.

In August, episcopal visitations were made to Christ the Redeemer Church, Warner Robins, Georgia (10th) and Saint Paul's Church, Crownsville, Maryland (31st).

The summer months witnessed several brilliant occasions of Sacred Ordination and Institution. On 6th August, the Reverend Father James Francis Sweeney was ordained to the Sacred Order of Priests *sub conditione* at Saint Barnabas Cathedral, Atlanta, Georgia. On 16th August, at Saint Alban's Cathedral, Oviedo, Florida, the Reverend Father Grant Raymond Brodrecht, Ph.D., was ordained to the Sacred Order of Priests, and the Reverend Mr. Daniel William Muth was ordained to the Sacred Order of Deacons. The following day, 17th August, the Very Reverend Peter Arthur Joslyn was instituted as Rector and Dean of Saint Alban's Cathedral Oviedo.

In September, my planned trip to Saint Matthew's Church, Riverview, Florida, was frustratingly interrupted by the closure of the Atlanta downtown connector, which debacle ceased all traffic to the airport. Mercifully, Bishop Bill Perkins was able to visit on my behalf a few weeks later. I was able to visit Holy Cross Church, Knoxville, Tennessee

(14th), Holy Trinity Church, Fernandina Beach, Florida (21st), and All Souls' Church, Asheboro, North Carolina (28th). A Zoom Standing Committee meeting was held on 25th September.

From 15th to 18th September, the Synod of the Province of Our Lady of Sorrows of the Society of the Holy Cross (SSC) gathered at Saint Barnabas Cathedral, Atlanta. On the day of my 15th anniversary of episcopal consecration, I was invited to celebrate High Mass and preach for the assembled brethren. It was a genuine delight and grace to welcome the SSC, Anglicanism's oldest priestly fraternity, to our APA Cathedral and Offices.

The weekend of 4th and 5th October was a spiritual bonanza as we celebrated Saint James-on-the-Glebe Parish in Gloucester, Virginia! Not only has Saint James been recognised as a parish, but the congregation now possesses its first Rector - we celebrated that weekend the Institution of the Reverend Father Kevin Christopher Fife. It was an intensely special celebration in that idyllic part of the Old Dominion. The Ecclesia Anglicana has been fully restored to that ancient county.

Also in October, an episcopal visitation was made to Saint Paul's Church, Melbourne, Florida (26th).

Over the past months, I have been rather involved in the administration of Nashotah House Theological Seminary as a member of the Corporation and Board of Visitors. Zoom meetings were held on 26th June and 18th September, and an in-person meeting was held from 14th to 16th October. The Anglican Joint Synods (G2) – Polish National Catholic Church (PNCC) Dialogue has been revived and met on Zoom on 6th October. Another Dialogue meeting will occur via Zoom on 4th December. It was wonderful to return to the Diocesan Women's Retreat from 22nd to 24th October at the Monastery of Our Lady of the Holy Spirit, Conyers, Georgia, to serve as retreat conductor. The retreat inexorably affords a time of thorough reflection and spiritual formation for our participants.

In November, episcopal visitations were made to Saint Peter the Apostle Church, Kingsport, Tennessee (9th), Saint Matthew's Church, Weaverville, North Carolina (16th), and scheduled for Saint Thomas the Apostle

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Church, Alto, Georgia (23rd). In December, an inaugural visitation is scheduled for our newest mission church, the Church of the Holy Communion, in Pensacola, Florida (14th). In January 2026, visitations are scheduled for Saint Patrick's Church, Brevard, North Carolina (11th) and All Saints' Church, Charlottesville, Virginia (25th). On 1st February, I intend to visit Saint Matthias Church in Dothan, Alabama.

Soon we anticipate the celebration of the Priestly Ordinations, God willing, of the Reverend John Scott Eddlemon, the Reverend Kyle Edward Williams, and the Reverend Daniel William Muth. Please persevere in prayer for them as they finalise their preparations for Ordination to the Holy Priesthood.

Report on Disciplinary Actions Concerning Robert Todd Giffin

Finally, I wish to share with you in this Presiding Bishop's Epistle a report that summarises the disciplinary measures which had to be taken against Robert Todd Giffin, formerly Bishop Ordinary of the Diocese of the Central and Western States, during August 2025. The actions were precipitated following Mr. Giffin's public declaration of intent to commit schism and separate from the canonical jurisdiction of the APA and the fellowship of the Anglican Joint Synods in order to establish an independent sect styled the 'Anglican Missionary Church.' Such a declaration was determined, under the Constitution and Canons (Canon 31, Sections 2 and 3), to constitute Abandonment of Communion. Notice of Inhibition and Declaration of Abandonment was given on 1st August and formal Deposition from the Sacred Episcopate and Ministry of the Church occurred on 30th August.

The Letter of Deposition further declares that the office of Bishop Ordinary of the Diocese of the Central and Western States (DCWS) is now vacant, and that episcopal oversight for the clergy and faithful of the canonical Diocese will be supplied by the House of Bishops of the APA.

These actions have ensured the continued canonical integrity and episcopal oversight of our Western Diocese. Because members of the former DCWS Standing Committee followed Mr. Giffin into schism, the structures of the Diocese of the Central and Western States and its

Standing Committee will be reorganised by the Provincial Synod of the APA in July 2026 in Crownsville, Maryland. By God's grace, three churches and ten clergy have remained faithful and loyal to the APA in our Western Diocese: Saint Mary of the Angels Church, LaPorte, Indiana, the Reverend Franklin Endres, Vicar; Holy Angels Church, Aloha, Oregon, the Reverend Vincent Varnas, Rector; Saint Andrew's Church, Jacksonville, Oregon, the Reverend Christopher Smith, Rector, and Reverend Mister John Watson, Deacon. Other non-parochial or retired priests remaining with the APA include Reverend Dr. Creighton Barnes, the Rev. Canon Robert Cheeseman, the Reverend Robert Kirk, the Reverend Mark Pavlina, the Reverend Charles Scott, the Reverend Gordon Wiebe, Ph.D., and Deaconess Suzanne Standiford. (The Reverend Yossi Sarid transferred to the DEUS as a non-geographical priest.) Let us renew our prayer and redouble our efforts to see the APA thrive and grow in the Western half of the nation.

Thank you!

It remains the most enormous privilege of my life to provide pastoral support and presence to and for you, to travel throughout our nation, to visit and boost as many of our churches and faithful as possible, and to bear testimony to the life and growth of our Communion. Together we are continuing to propel the One, Holy, Catholic, and Apostolic Church in her Anglican expression. Please continually pray for our clergy, people, and parishes. From October 21 – 29, Bishop David Haines, Missionary Bishop for Global Partnerships, together with Father Paul Rivard, Rector of Saint George the Martyr Church, Simpsonville, South Carolina, visited the newest Global Partner, Saint Swithin's Anglican Church in Manado, Indonesia. During the visit, the Rector of the parish, Father

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Juris Kangihade, signed the Oath of Conformity and received his License to Officiate in the APA. Bishop Haines baptized one member and confirmed five members of the rapidly growing congregation.

The Bishop and Father Paul also visited the land that has been donated to the parish, where a new Church building is to be built. On the Monday before their departure, the APA team also visited with the Indonesian Bible Society and with the only Rabbi in Indonesia, Rabbi Yaakov Baruch.
